

Welcome to the 2023 Bend, OR Christmas Parade "The Lights of Christmas"

Dear Friends and Christmas Parade Participants:

The annual Bend Christmas Parade will take place on Saturday, December 2,2023 at noon in downtown Bend. The Parade Theme this year is "The Lights of Christmas." We'll see lots of fun floats with interpretations of this theme!

As has been the case for over 30 years, the Christmas Parade is organized by an all-volunteer, non-profit committee made up of a cross-section of Bend citizens. We welcome individuals, marching units, floats, drill teams, choral groups, churches, businesses, non-profits and animal groups to enter the parade. Certificates of participation are given to all entries and award ribbons are given to the top three judged entries in eight different categories. A modest fee for most entrants helps to defray parade expenses.

All people of all belief systems are cordially invited and welcome to participate in the Bend Christmas Parade, so long as entries participate in the positive spirit of the Christmas season, are non-divisive and contribute to goodwill and building up our community. To maintain the quality of the parade, all entries must be highly decorated in the spirit of the Christmas season and should adhere to the Parade Theme. Read the rules governing the parade carefully and fill out the entry form completely before submission.

The 2.5-mile parade route starts on the intersection of NW Newport Blvd. and NW Harmon Blvd. It runs East on Newport, turns south on Wall Street, and then meanders along Riverside Blvd. before it crosses the Galveston St. bridge and ends at Harmon. Many thousands of happy people will line the route.

HOW TO ENTER: Use the Parade Entry Packet. Deadline for entry is NOVEMBER 21, 2023, however the event will most likely fill sooner. It is your responsibility to mail (or email - preferred) your entry form on time and to confirm that it has been received by the deadline date. If you do not receive a confirming email, please call (or email) to confirm that your entry has been received.

The Bend Police Department, insurance carriers and the volunteer parade organizers have placed a limit on the number of entries for safety purposes. You must turn in your entry form by deadline for committee review. If your entry is NOT acceptable for any reason, you will be notified immediately upon receipt of your entry form. If your entry is accepted, you will be notified approximately ten days before the parade date regarding your line-up position and time for your arrival.

First, Second and Third Place ribbons will be awarded to those being judged first, second, or third in each category. The eight categories are listed below. The First Place winner's name will also be announced from the review stand. All parade entries will receive a participation certificate.
